

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

DIRECTIONS:

From Ithaca via NY 34B: Left onto Sharpsteen Rd. Right onto County Hwy-153/Pleasant Valley Rd. Take the 1st left onto Smith Rd/County Hwy-178. The site is on the left.

From Syracuse via I-81S: 81S to exit 12 for US-11/NY-41/NY-281 toward Homer/Cortland. Merge with Main Street Connector. Left onto SR-281/NY-281 about 2.2 miles. Right onto SR222/NY-222 for 9.2 miles. Left onto Main St NY-38. Take 1st right onto Spring St - County Hwy100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext County Hwy-190. Take the 1st Left onto Smith Rd/County Hwy-178. The site is on the right.

From Binghamton via I-81N: 81N to exit 11 for NY-13 toward Cortland. Left onto Clinton Ave/NY-13. Stay straight to go onto Groton Ave/NY-222. Follow for about 10.4 miles. Left onto Main St. Groton, NY-38. Take 151 right onto Spring St/County Hwy-100. Stay straight to go onto Spring Street Ext./County Hwy-190. Take 151 Left onto Smith Rd/County Hwy-178. Site is on the right.

From Rochester via I-490/I-90: after merging onto I-90 toward Albany, take exit 41 for NY-414 toward Waterloo/Clyde. Merge onto Ridge Rd/NY-414 toward Waterloo/Seneca Falls/Montezuma. Left onto SR-318/NY-318. Left onto US-20/NY-5. Continue for about 11.7 miles. Right onto North Street/NY-34/NY-38. Continue for about 24.8 miles. Left onto North Lancing School Rd which becomes West Groton Rd/County Hwy-100. Turn Right to stay on West Groton Rd/County Hwy100. After 1/2 mile, make a slight Right onto Smith Rd/County Hwy-178. Site is on Right

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4.”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older on the first day of the trial.
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run, and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or barking.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring.

- Handlers have a choice regarding dogs wearing collars. Dogs may run courses with or without one collar. Collars should preferably be quick release style, and may be flat buckle, rolled leather, or flea prevention. No attachments of any kind are allowed on the collar.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may not be used to take a dog into the ring.
- The Handler may choose to carry their leash during the run. The leash must be in a pocket or tied around the body.

- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

IDTC will offer Declared Training in the Ring for their trials. The handler has the option to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run. The handler must approach the Judge **PRIOR** to the start of the class, either during the walk-through or earlier, for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- The handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be DTIR. The handler is allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

The following items are considered training in the ring (See Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4-paw rule (directing the dog back onto the contract)
- Start line stay, i.e., leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle. Repositioning or repeated commands before the handler leaves the dog can result in a delay of the start penalty.
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point game.

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (including fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10 feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5-fault penalty to eliminate any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and/or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
